## HAIR

## ACT I and ACT II:

Every female student in ACT I and ACT II will wear their hair in a ballet bun. Hair will be pulled straight back in the front, including bangs. There should be NO part. Any hair left hanging on the base of the neck should be pinned into the bun. It is often easiest to slightly wet hair and apply gel when pulling hair back. Cover the bun with an <u>invisible</u> hairnet that matches the hair color and heavily hairspray. Please see the photos below to use as a guide for the placement of the bun on the back of the head. Do NOT use donut bun makers. Suggested hairnets: Bunheads Invisible Hairnets (#BH420); <u>www.discountdance.com</u>

## For ACT III:

Every female student in ACT III will wear their hair in a low ponytail with NO part. Hair will be pulled straight back in the front, including bangs. There should be NO part. Any hair left hanging on the base of the neck should be pinned up. It is often easiest to slightly wet hair and apply gel when pulling hair back. Secure the ponytail with a hairband that matches hair color (blonde, brown, black, red, etc.) and heavily hairspray. Please see the photo to use as a guide for the placement of the bun on the back of the head.
