

ADDITIONAL PRODUCTION INFORMATION

- Label all items (shoes, tights, costumes, etc).
- **Please do not wear your costume to and from the dress rehearsal or the production- however, tights ARE permitted.** It is suggested to use a zippered robe/swimsuit cover-up to alleviate any messing with hair or makeup. You can find an example here: [Zippered Cover-Up](#)
- No nail polish.
- No jewelry unless noted per costume.
- Reminder that dancers should not wear underwear with their costumes. Their tights serve as underwear.
- Bring extra supplies such as hairpins, bobby pins, hairspray, gel, make-up, band-aids, sewing kit, and consider bringing an extra pair of tights.
- Bring an extra black leotard, in case of emergencies.
- If your dancer is in multiple dances, consider bringing a small collapsible hamper or laundry basket that can be used to store costumes and shoes if there are quick changes.
- For some of our older and more advanced students who are in many dances and often perform throughout the year, a garment steamer may be a good investment. This can assist with removing wrinkles from costumes.
- If your dancer is in multiple dances, the **Dream Duffel** may also be a great investment. It offers a great way to transport and store items. The garment bags are nice because they have multiple pockets that can store tights, hairpieces, etc. Our students typically purchase the medium size bags. *It makes a great birthday present!*
